In Baja California's Great Mural Art, animals leap past the stillness of solidly standing people with up-stretched arms. One site may resemble a parade or procession of rushing animals; another may resemble the chorus from a Puccini opera, cheering an array of ascending animals; or the reverse, where animals below appear to venerate a personage high on a cliff above. Other murals are more like crowded double exposures of highly overpainted blurs of man and beast. Most sites exhibit visual clues of human-animal interdependence, suggesting they are partners for survival. Partners for Life. This lecture will focus on these visual clues.
